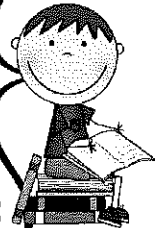

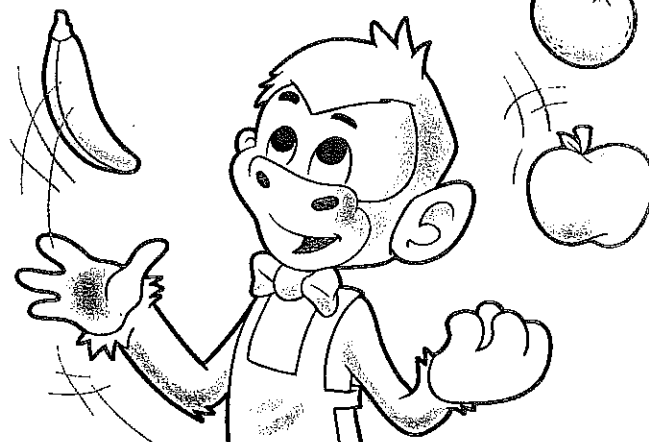

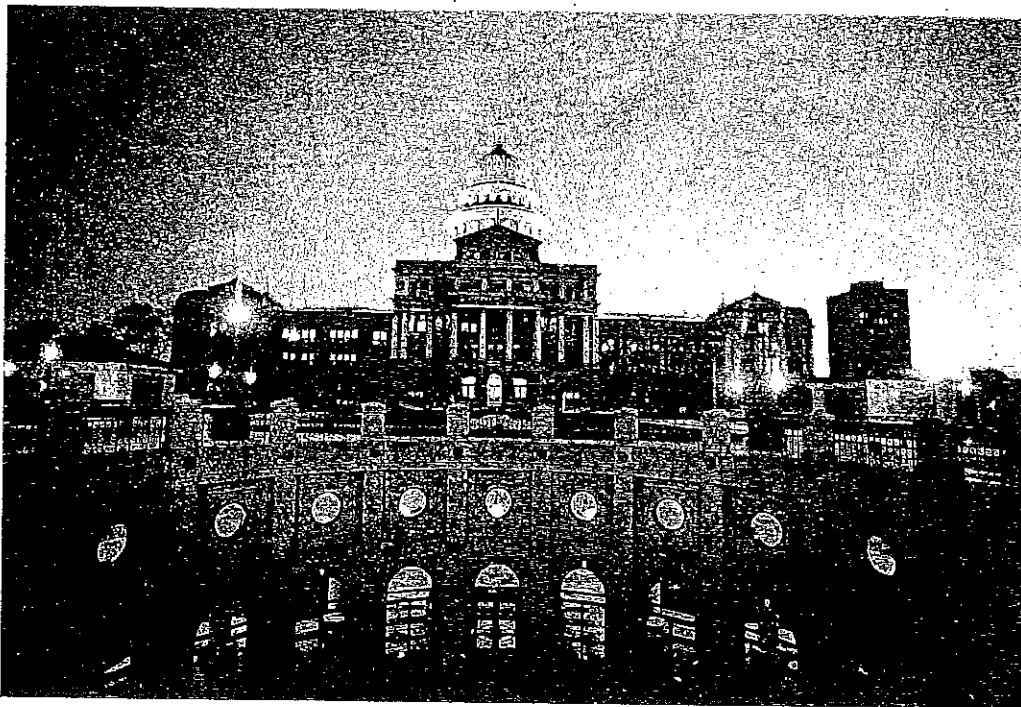

The Texas Capitol Building

- 1 A state capitol is an important building. The governor and other state leaders work there. Many people visit there.
- 2 The Texas state capitol is in Austin. It is the largest capitol in any of the states. It took six years to build. It was finished in 1888. The building looks pink. That is because of the kind of rock that was used to build it.
- 3 The capitol has many statues and paintings. Many honor past leaders of Texas. It has a large, round room in the center. Its very high ceiling is a big dome. In the center of the dome is a star. The star stands for Texas—the Lone Star State.
- 4 Stars are found in other parts of the building too. There is a large room on the second floor where lawmakers work. Two special lights hang from the ceiling. There is a star in the middle of each light. A letter shines in each point of the star. The letters spell T-E-X-A-S.
