



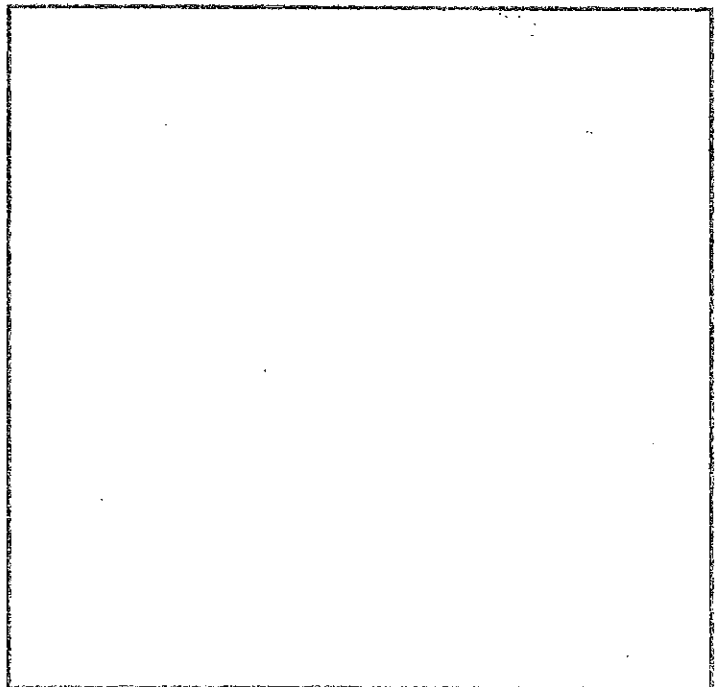
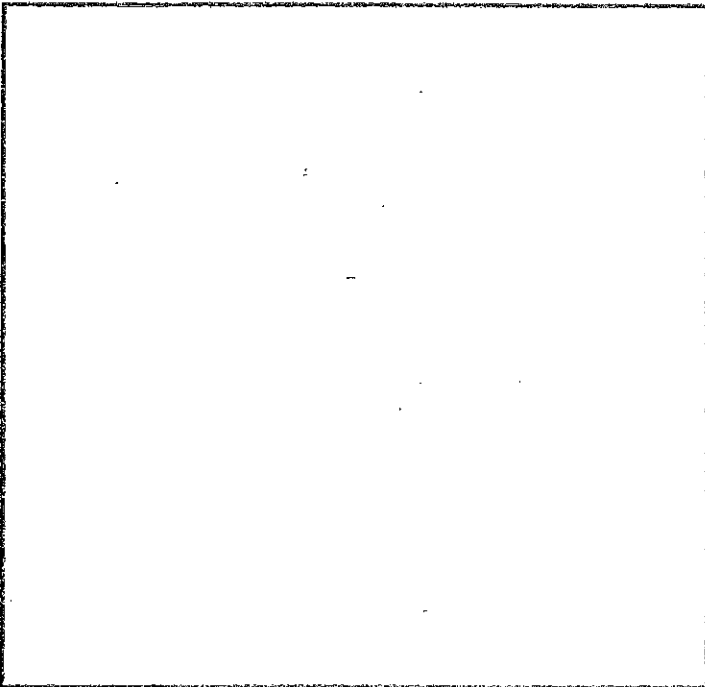
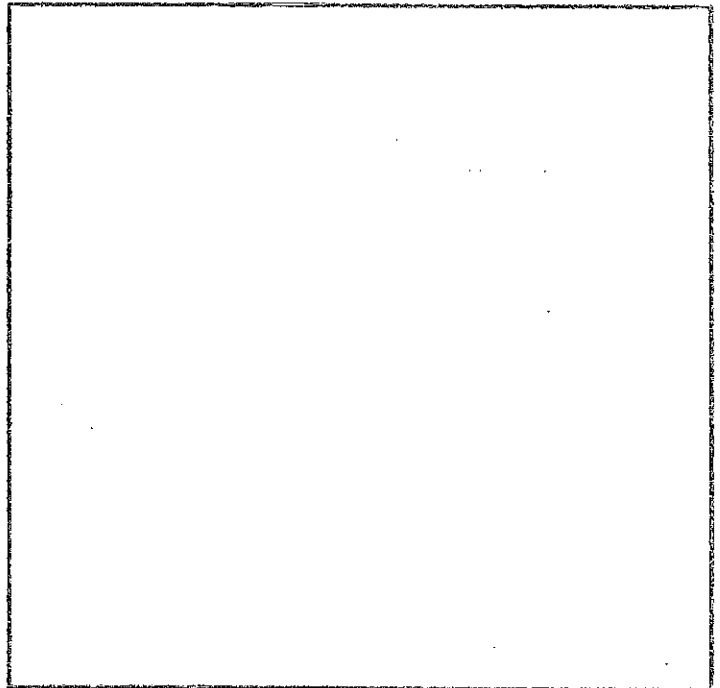
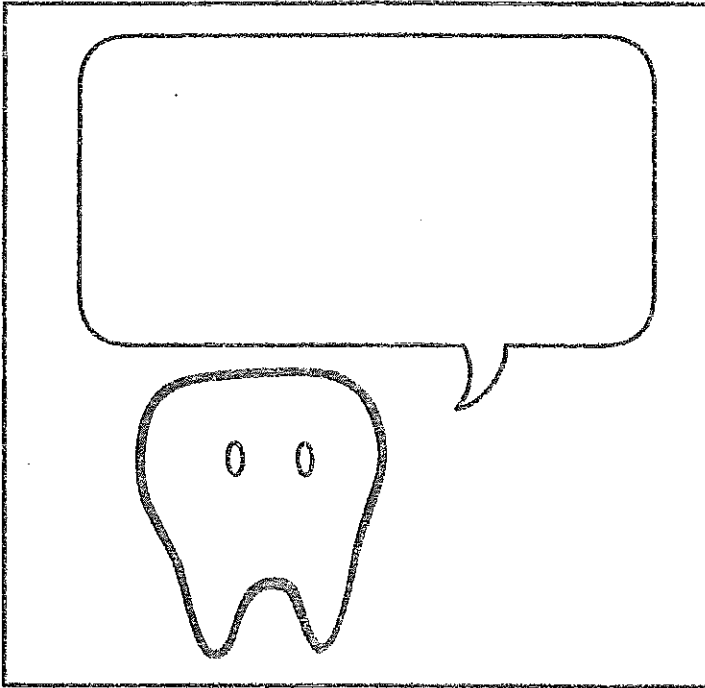
Make a comic strip to show a day in the life of a tooth.

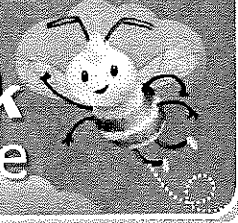
Here are some tips for making your comic strip:
