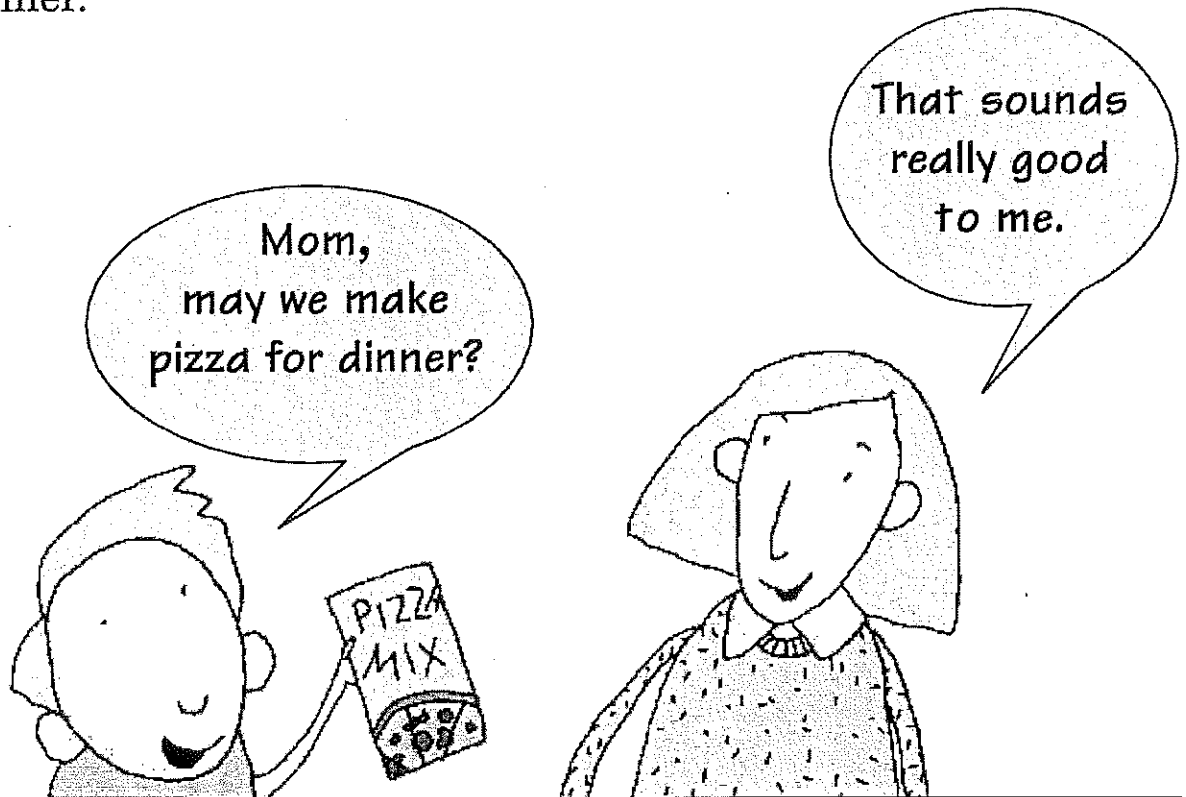

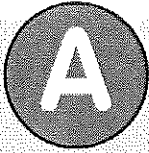
Quotation Marks Before and After a Speaker's Words

Comic strips make it easy to tell who is speaking. They use speech balloons. Here Mom and Steve are talking about dinner.

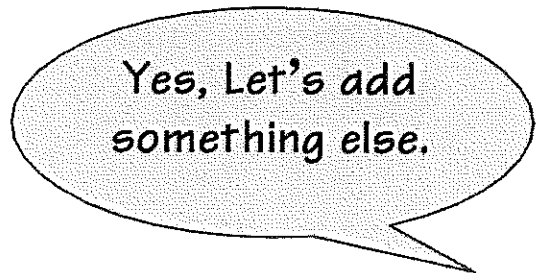


When you write sentences, you use **quotation marks** to show the speaker's exact words.

"That sounds really good to me," Mom said.

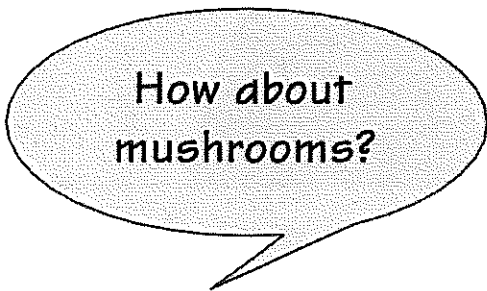
