If you need to practice the words of the week, here are some ideas.
Keep this in your Maverick folder.

1. Write each word and circle the vowels (a, e, i, o, u) and underline the consonants.
2. Write the words and a synonym (similar word) for each word.
3. Write the words and an antonym (opposite word) for each word.
4. Write a story using all of your words.
5. Make a spelling rainbow.
6. Write your words in a sentence and underline them in each sentence. Tell if the word is used as a noun (person, place, or thing), verb (action word), or adjective (describing word). Don't do words that don't fit these categories.
7. Make a comic strip using the words.
8. Pyramid write your words. Example: Cloud

9. Cut out letters from old newspapers and magazines to spell each of your words. Glue the words onto your paper.
10. Divide each word into syllables using the Spalding Spelling method.
11. Write the words in ABC order.
12. Type your words on the computer 3 times each using different fonts, sizes, and colors if you want. Make sure you do not use fonts that are symbols.
13. Use your words to make a word search or another type of puzzle using www.puzzlemaker.com. Complete it after printing.
