



What Are We Learning?

Language Arts:

- We will answer questions about non-fiction text using text evidence.
- Review cause and effect, retelling, and asking “thick” questions.
- Use the writing process to write a story about a piece of candy corn traveling through the digestive system and focus on using strong verbs.
- Continue learning about declarative, interrogative, exclamatory, and imperative sentences.

Math:

- Use open number lines, partial 100’s charts, and place value to solve 2 and 3 digit addition and subtraction word problems.
